



# STOP ETHNIC CLEANSING

For centuries Travellers have been persecuted and harassed across Europe. Now Dale Farm - the UK's largest Traveller site - is under imminent threat of eviction, with the Tory run Basildon council determined to bulldoze half of the homes at Dale Farm.

DALE FARM NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT



**D**ale Farm was a former scrapyard and is now home to 1,000 people. They own the land and have been there for three decades. Despite this the council are determined to exploit the recent rise in anti-migrant racism to bulldoze more than fifty family homes in what threatens to be the largest eviction in recent history.

Basildon council has set aside more than a third of its annual budget for the eviction, and the central government have funded most of the policing operation. When we can find more than £18 million to evict families from their own land but can't find the funds to keep nurseries, libraries and youth centres open - something has gone terribly wrong.

The people facing eviction have not been offered new pitches, or other suitable accommodation. Those who have already been evicted have suffered homelessness and police harassment as they try to find places to sleep.

**The Dale Farm community is struggling for survival, and we can support them.**

## **Help fight this eviction**

Authorities have given families until midnight on August 31st to abandon their homes or have them destroyed. On August 27th, the long weekend before the ultimatum expires, we plan to set up Camp Constant, to provide around the clock solidarity and resistance to the eviction. Come for a weekend of direct action training, workshops, and a bit of a party on Saturday night. There will be sleeping places in homes, or camping space, and people are encouraged to spend additional nights at Dale Farm as we might not know the exact date of the eviction until it starts.
